The project is part of a system of paths as a place of experience, a place of passage staging, relationship, encounter, rest. The building reclines on the ground, is inserted between the trees and rocks, around them, makes them its own, to go down to look out over the lake to frame the landscape.

The large window becomes a sort of natural picture that retrieves the elements of the landscape and makes building elements. This view discovers that the lake is already sought from the landing of the woods: it is already possible perceived the presence of water from afar. The patios dig the building, spanning trees integrating them into the project; the drawing spaces become domestic and reserved. The nature becomes the protagonist of the inner life. The natural elements, the trees, the rocks, the water suggest the configuration and morphology of the space as a result. The formal structure of the project could be reshaped in the face of scientific standing of the existing trees.
